With the COVID-19 just behind us, life is slowly trending towards the "new normal". As shown by the gradual increase of members coming back to participate the two main activities, namely the "Enjoy Yourself Day (EYD)" and the Chinese Language School (CLS).

Despite the continual increase in the bank lending rate, interest gain on our deposits in the bank, which is part of our source of income, still remains stagnant.

Due to the reduction of number of students attending our Chinese Language School, the Per -Capita Grant received in 2022-23 was reduced by almost \$4,000 when compared to the previous financial year. The payment of superannuation to the teachers this year adds the burden of expenditure in the balance sheet.

Having said that, we are blessed by the lastminute award of Technology Grant by the Government which turned our deficit into a small profit.

As for the Enjoy Yourself Day (EYD) program, despite the gradual increase of participation by both members and non-member, we are still yet to make a profit.

Looking forward to the future, we are reviewing our existing program and investigate the possibility of running additional programs to fulfil our members' needs plus improving our Association's profile.

this Association relies on, apart from all participation members, we also need those elected Committee Members who form the core of the decision making and guiding the direction of the Association as to where it heads. Note that it is the constitutional requirement that a minimum of four Committee Members to be present in a meeting to hold discussion in various matters relating to the Association. In the past year, there was occasion that committee meeting was cancelled due to insufficient Committee Member number at the committee meeting. We, therefore, urgently need additional new blood to join us to ensure the continuity in the smooth running of the Association. I, therefore, am calling for members of this Association to join and participate in the role of Committee Member. In joining the team, you will be able to appreciate how the Association is being run and, most importantly, you can also contribute by suggesting how the association could improve to ensure members are served to your expectation.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS

Note 1 Statement of Accounting Policies

This is a special purpose report prepared to provide accounts which satisfy the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (NSW). The Management Committee has determined that the Association is not a reporting entity and therefore there is no requirement to comply general accounting standards in the preparation and presentation of this financial report. This determination complies with the provision of the Associations Incorporation Act that the preparation of financial statements in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards is not mandatory for a Tier 2 association such as the Cherrybrook Chinese Community Association Inc.

The Management Committee has further determined that any assets or liabilities not brought into the accounts were insignificant and therefore have not been provided in this report.

The statements are prepared on a mainly cash basis whereby items are brought to account as money is paid or received by the Association while some special items are bought to account on an accrual basis.

The accounts have been prepared on a historical cost basis and rounded off to the nearest dollars. Where necessary, comparative figures have been reclassified to conform to any changes in presentation made in this financial report.

The principal accounting policies adopted by the Association are broadly consistent with those of the previous year and are stated to assist in a general understanding of the report.

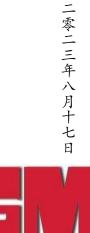
